The event will be held in the Swedish Cultural Center in Seattle, WA. The annual fundraiser is an important source of funding for SCPI and the employees who sacrifice so much to work there since the first dinner event. We really appreciate the presence and contribution from all attendees and donors at the last two events. The theme of the event in 2015 is "**Henry's Story**". As you may know, Dr. Deisher's younger son, Henry was diagnosed with aggressive Burkitt's lymphoma on July 30, 2014. Henry has been fighting hard against the horrific side effects and pain from the chemotherapy. He has been under the constant care of his mother, Dr. Deisher, his family and excellent medical team at Seattle Children's Hospital. Significantly, many pediatric oncologists have also thought that human fetal vaccines may contribute to childhood leukemia and lymphoma. This issue was discussed since 2010 when a pediatric oncologist spoke at the

Washington State Medical Association meeting about her suspicions of a link between fetal MMR@II vaccines and childhood leukemia and lymphoma. Therefore, Dr. Deisher decided to put an investigation on human fetal vaccine and childhood leukemia/lymphoma research as the organizational goal in July 2014. After Dr. Deisher has sacrificed her commercial career to conduct research specific to protecting children from the dangers of these vaccines, it is terrible that her own son has become a victim of human fetal vaccines.

We don't want to see any more children suffered from such terrible diseases like Henry, and we have to stop these manufacturing human fetal vaccines NOW!

2) Another Sound Choice's peer-reviewed study "*Sociological Environmental Causes are Insufficient to Explain Autism Changepoints of Incidence*" has been accepted to be published in Spring issue 2015 of *Issues in Law and Medicine*. This study conducted an expanded analysis of Autism disorder (AD) changepoints in California and U.S., and determined whether changepoints in time trends of AD rates temporally coincide with changepoints for the proposed causative sociologic and environmental factors. Sociologic factors were represented by quantitative data such as the number of Yahoo chat groups discussing autism, the number of scientific publications referring to autism, and the number of professionals qualified to diagnose autism. Our work demonstrated that the temporal changes in the rise of autistic disorder do not correspond to temporal changes in sociologic factors such as increased parental and professional awareness, or federal special education funding. We will update more information when it is officially published!

3) January 22nd, 2015 is the day of March for Life with the theme; "Every Life is a Gift." This theme particularly emphasizes the value of babies prenatally diagnosed with disabilities such as Down Syndrome and Spina Bifida, children who are aborted at alarmingly high rate, as high as 90%. As many of you know, the March for Life is an annual pro-life rally protesting abortion that is usually held on the anniversary of the United States Supreme Court's decision, January 22nd, 1973. Dr. Deisher and other SCPI employees marched in Olympia, WA in 2010, and in Washington DC in the last three years spreading the words about our mission and

raising awareness of the dangers of aborted human fetal cell derived vaccines in heavy snow. Unfortunately we are not participating March for Life 2015 in Washington DC due to lack of resources. According to the news by National Religious Broadcast (NRB), Jeanne Monahan, President of the March for Life Education and Defense Fund, has invited pastors nationwide to come with members of their congregations to Washington, DC for the March for Life, 2015. If you live near Washington DC, it would be a great opportunity to meet the pastors from all over the United States and tell them about Sound Choice and that aborted human fetal cell derived vaccines have been causing autism and childhood leukemia and lymphoma.

Not only prenatal babies lives, but also postnatal babies' and all children's lives should be protected from any potential and preventable fatal diseases. How many more children must suffer so horribly before we stop exploiting other human beings for medicine, harming others inadvertently in the process.
